



RULES & ETIQUETTE SKATERS

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Good conduct on and off the ice are a *must*. If this rule is not followed the student may be asked to leave the program *without a refund*.

- If for any reason you are getting off the ice, let your coach know.
- Do not loiter on the ice after a fall... keep moving.
- Jeans are not appropriate attire.
- Bobbie pins and other loose hairpins are not allowed as they create a serious hazard if they fall onto the ice.
- Food and drinks are not allowed on the ice. This includes chewing gum!
- Skaters and their parents should not interfere with a coach and/or student during a lesson.
- When a skater's solo music is being played, move aside for that skater so that they may proceed.
- Music will be played for coaches first and all others in the order they are requested.
- Foul language is not acceptable on the ice or in the dressing rooms and you will be asked to leave the ice after one warning.
- Conflicts between skaters should be brought to the attention of the Coaches and/or executive members **in writing** for resolution.
- Coaches and the Board Members have the authority to ask skaters to leave the ice.
- A permission form will be required from your home club test chairperson or the President before you will be allowed to try a test at another club.

This form must be signed by both skater and parent and must be returned

to the club first night of skating or the skater will not be allowed on the ice.
